The external school review was completed last term and we are currently waiting for the report from the Department of Education and Training. This is a new review process and our school was one of the first to go through it, it took us 3 full days to complete.

The need for new student toilets was recognised by the School Council and also by the Department of Education and Training. As you know, the State Government gave us \$150,000 towards the cost of the new toilet block – which is roughly half the expected total cost. We will have to pay the rest.

Planning for the new student toilet block is well under way and the new toilets should be ready for the 2019 school year. The Junior School Council is doing a fantastic job and we love their enthusiasm.

Have you checked out the new classroom library in your child's room? The students and teachers have been hard at work designing new library spaces in their classrooms. I had a quick look on the night of our August School Council meeting and they look absolutely fantastic! We've started purchasing new books for the classroom libraries – so the children will have exciting new books to read soon.
