Numeracy Intervention: G.R.I.N.

Overview of G.R.I.N. Intervention Program

The G.R.I.N. Intervention Program is intended to provide opportunities for students who are working below the expected level in mathematics to be “front-loaded” with pre-knowledge of the mathematical content that will be covered during each lesson.

The aim of this program is to build student’s mathematical confidence and for students to reach an appropriate standard in Mathematics so they can function successfully in their classroom and specialist programs.

G.R.I.N. sessions are conducted in addition to and before the normal daily mathematics lessons by a tutor. A tutor conducts the sessions with small groups of students. The main focus of these lessons are to familiarise students with the relevant language and terminology that they will use and hear during the classroom lesson and for the tutor to model what students can expect to see and/or do in the lesson. Each G.R.I.N. session is brief runs for approximately 15-25 minutes.
